University of California
Santa Cruz, CA

July 18 - 23, 1978

U.C. Santa Cruz sits high on the hill overlooking the city of Santa Cruz and Monterey Bay, 80 miles south of San Francisco. The beautiful campus is composed of modern wood and stucco buildings, surrounded by redwoods, and the campus recreation complex includes a swimming pool, tennis courts, racquet ball, and other facilities. We are just minutes from the beach and the boardwalk in Santa Cruz. Meals will be served in the campus dining room, and accommodations are two to a room.

Our festival Saturday will be with the community of Santa Cruz.

Central

Trout Lodge
Potosi, MO

Trout Lodge is a YMCA family camp, located 80 miles south of St. Louis. Nestled in the foothills of the Ozarks, the camp is on the edge of a 350 acre lake, and offers swimming and boating, as well as tennis, archery, horseback riding, hiking and fishing. The food is prepared in the camp kitchen, and is served family style. Accommodations are three to a room (BRING A SLEEPING BAG).

The Saturday festival will be with the family campers staying at Trout Lodge.

East

Fellowship Farm
Pottstown, PA

August 8 - 13, 1978

Fellowship began in Philadelphia in 1931 as an organization to foster better human relations among people of all racial, ethnic and religious groups. The Farm, located about an hour from Philly, is in the Pennsylvania Dutch Country and has 60 acres of woods, a swimming pool, tennis courts, a hilltop meditation center, and plenty of open space on the 126 acre farm. The food is hearty and delicious, and accommodations are mainly three to a room with one dormitory. The week will include a visit to the famous "Games Preserve" in Fleetwood, PA.

Our Saturday festival will be with people of all races and ages from the Fellowship and Pottstown community.



Examples of people you are likely to meet at a New Games Camps

Bring

Bring loose comfortable clothing and tennis shoes for active playing, indoors and outdoors. (Warm jackets, swim suits, change of clothes, etc.) Check under "About the Sites" to see if you need to bring a sleeping bag.

Bring highly portable musical instruments and arts materials you want to play with and share.

Travel

Participants are responsible for making their own travel arrangements. We will send you directions by car, and airplane/bus connections. We will provide transportation from the nearest airline limousine or bus terminal.

Tax Deduction

Treasury Regulation 1.162-5 permits an income tax deduction for educational expenses (registration fees, cost of travel, meals and lodgings) undertaken to:

1. Maintain or improve skills required in one's employment or other trade or business, or
2. Meet express requirements of employer or a law imposed as a condition to retention of employment, job status, or rate of compensation.

Cost & Cancellations

The cost for the camp is \$150.00, including room and board for five nights. Enrollment is limited to 30 people. Advance registration and payment is required to reserve a space.

Cancellations three weeks prior to the camp will be subject to a \$10 cancellation fee. Cancellations less than three weeks prior to the camp are subject to a \$25 cancellation fee. Cancellations must be received at least one week in advance of the camp.
