ONE-DAY WORKSHOPS

The New Games Foundation also conducts one-day workshops for up to 40 participants. A workshop gives a general orientation to New Games and generally includes refereeing and applications of New Games. Special emphasis can be given to areas of particular interest to the sponsor.

The cost is \$750 plus travel and expenses for one New Games trainer.

Books and materials are not included.
